## Memorandum of Understanding Regarding Technology Stipends for OP/PT and Certificated Employees

The Tacoma Education Association/Tacoma School District Collective Bargaining Agreement and the Office Professional/Professional Technical/ Tacoma School District Collective Bargaining Agreement provided for additional optional pay for Employees of the bargaining units through the 2016-17 school year. The District has outlined continued optional day opportunities for members of both Associations as stated below:

An additional seven (7) hours of District approved professional development technology training will be available to Office Professional/Professional Technical and Certificated employees in 2017-18, and 2018-19. These hours will be self-directed. Employees will be allowed to use the additional hours of work for in-service professional development activities outside regular work hours or on non-work days approved by the District.
